School Accolades & Notable Activities

- Mt. Vernon High School is hosting a NASA Exhibit in their media center through December 13 called "Apollo and the Next Giant Leap!" This local exhibit is made possible thanks to the Mt. Vernon Education Foundation, the Main Street Arts at the Carnegie, and NASA. An actual moon rock was on display for the opening night.
- With over 50% of Mt. Vernon teachers requesting to attend the "Red for Ed" day at the Statehouse, MVCSC has decided to have November 19 as an eLearning Day and support the teachers as they provide a unified voice to legislators, advocating for education.
- Mt. Vernon Food Service celebrated National School Lunch Week with trivia, prizes, and musical entertainment, which included Mt. Vernon Middle School Principal Ben Williams and some students.

- Mt. Vernon High School Football team won sectionals.
