GREAT NEWS IN THE SCHOOLS

School Accolades & Notable Activities

- Miss Tessa Freeman was one of two seniors in Hancock County to win the Lilly Endowment Scholarship!
- MVMS 8th Grade Treble Choir made it to the top five choirs for the B105.7 FM Christmas Choir competition.
- For the first time in school history, the MVHS Football Team won regionals and advanced to semi-state.
- MVMS Mr. Douglass's Project Lead the Way class designed and built toys for people with cerebral palsy.
- FES teacher, Mrs. Privett, Principal, Mrs. Muffler, and students donated \$100 to Make-a-Wish on behalf of a student to help him receive his Make-a-Wish come true.
- Mt. Vernon had 16 students and two teachers from Taiwan visit Mt. Vernon Schools for a week. These students interacted and engaged in many classroom activities, as well as a full English immersion experience as they stayed at host families. Many hugs and tears were shed when the host families and students had to part ways. Mt. Vernon will be sending several students to visit them in Taipei next summer, so it will be a true student exchange.

Community Connections

- Local police officers supported local students in need by taking them shopping, which included Mt. Vernon students. Several local organizations helped to fund this initiative, including Daniel's Vineyard, Meijer, McCordsville Police Department, Vernon Township Fire Department, Buck Creek Fire Department, and others.
- MVHS began their Career Exploration program for students, sponsored by the Mt. Vernon Education Foundation. Students heard from industry representatives from Ambrose Property Group, Marriott IndyPlace Hotels, Hancock Health, Rivers Financial Services, and Eli Lilly and Company.
- Several choirs, bands, and cheerleaders from MVMS, MVHS and MCE performed throughout the community in a variety of performances, including the Indianapolis Symphonic Choir and Orchestra, at Meijer, as well as performing & marching in the Fortville Winterfest.
- The Fortville Lions Club, Mt. Vernon Optimist Club, and the Fortville Psi Iota Xi held the annual Breakfast with Santa event; many volunteer MV clubs and teams helped with the successful event.
- MVEF recently distributed over \$20,000 in grants at all five schools, including a MVMS grant for ceramic heart kits from Hearts of Hope. Our MVMS students will be supporting other students experiencing a tragedy with this grant. Another grant was at MCE where new quality fiction and non-fiction books will help provide a broader range of options to reach our English Language Learners and all students.
- Superintendent Dr. Parker and his team experienced a day in the life of a MVCSC food service team. The group helped to prepare and serve the holiday meal in November.
- Ambrose Property Group, a new district business owner who is developing a property near MCE, donated over 40 toys to our students in need.
