

HCPL FUNDING IS UNIQUE


A CEDIT fund for HCPL (Hancock County Public Library) and FVTPL (Fortville-Vernon Township Public Library) was established in 1999 – IC 6-3.5-7-23

Hancock County Library funding is based off property tax calculations


Both libraries have the same budget process as if funded by property tax

Neither library can take additional money from CEDIT funds over the property tax calculation

This funding source has been a creative and efficient way to fund library service in Hancock County for more than 20 years

- A\V includes Movies, Games, Audiobooks, Music CDs



IMAGINATION LIBRARY

- PARTNERSHIP WITH THE HANCOCK COUNTY COMMUNITY FOUNDATION
- EACH CHILD RECEIVES A BOOK PER MONTH AT HOME FROM BIRTH TO AGE 5
- OVER 2,600 ENROLLED IN THE PROGRAM
- ENDOWMENT GOAL HAS BEEN REACHED!!!!
