Re: 2022-2023 Lunch Prices- Corrected

Date: September 13th, 2022

Due to current USDA waivers, the state of Indiana is not requiring the completion of the Paid Lunch Equity Tool. However, since the previous memo there has been an update in requirements for adult meal pricing, including the updated reimbursement rates. The requirement for adult breakfast pricing is the student paid price (\$2.25) plus the paid reimbursement rate (\$0.50). The adult lunch pricing is highest student paid price (\$3.50) plus paid meal reimbursement (\$0.85) plus value of USDA donated foods (\$0.43). Therefore, I recommend a change to the adult breakfast and lunch prices as follows:
