# School Accolades & Notable Activities

- Shout out to MVMS social studies teacher, Jeff Crague, who has been selected for the position of David M. Rubenstein "Master Teacher of the White House History Teacher Institute" this upcoming summer in Washington. In this position, he will be helping to facilitate professional development with the education team at the White House Historical Association to 30 teachers from across the U.S. My focus will be on developing lessons geared toward middle school teachers and helping them to implement the material into their classrooms.
- Congratulations to MVHS Senior, Mya Adams, who was selected as one of the two county finalists for the Lilly Endowment Scholarship and will receive a four-year tuition at an Indiana college or university.
- MVHS Junior, Micah Gaston, earned a scholarship from the Commemorative Air Force to attain his pilot's license as early as 17 years old.
- As part of Mt. Vernon's expanded vocational class offerings, our first-year MVHS criminal justice students
  recently became Indiana Law Enforcement Academy (ILEA) State Certified Jail Officers after completing a
  rigorous 40-hour Jail Officer certification course. In addition, eight second-year Criminal Justice students became
  the first to successfully become Emergency Telecommunicator Certified (ETC) within the Career and Technical
  Education (CTE) program. These students completed a rigorous 40-hour training period to become certified
  during the past nine weeks that will assist them should they seek a career in communications within a
  Dispatch/911 Center.
- MVCSC held our second job fair in November. Approximately 25 people have attended our job fairs, and the last statistics showed that approximately half were offered a position at MV.
- MVHS sophomore, Hannah Hauser, was named cross country athlete of the year for the second year in a row. At state, Hauser placed the highest in the county at #82.
- Several MVHS football players received Honorable Mentions for the IndyStar ALL-USA Central Indiana high school football Super Team 2023: Joliba Brogan, Jr., Tre Jones, Sr., DJ Johnson, Jr.
