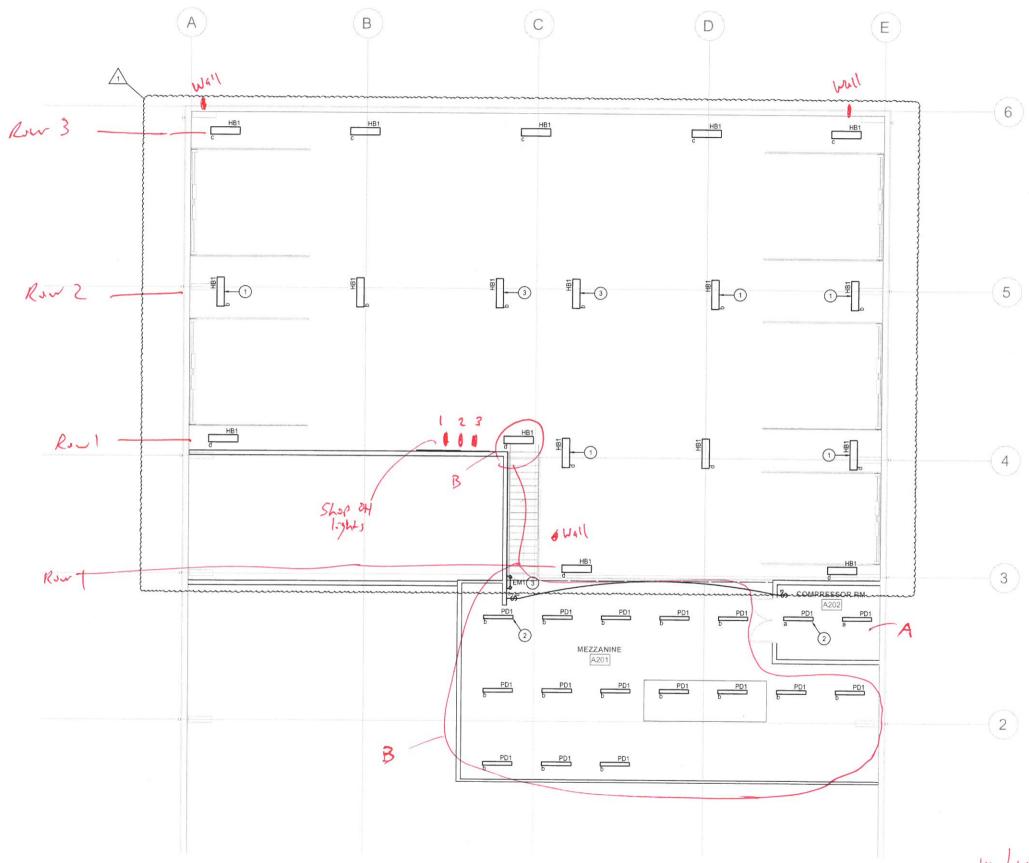

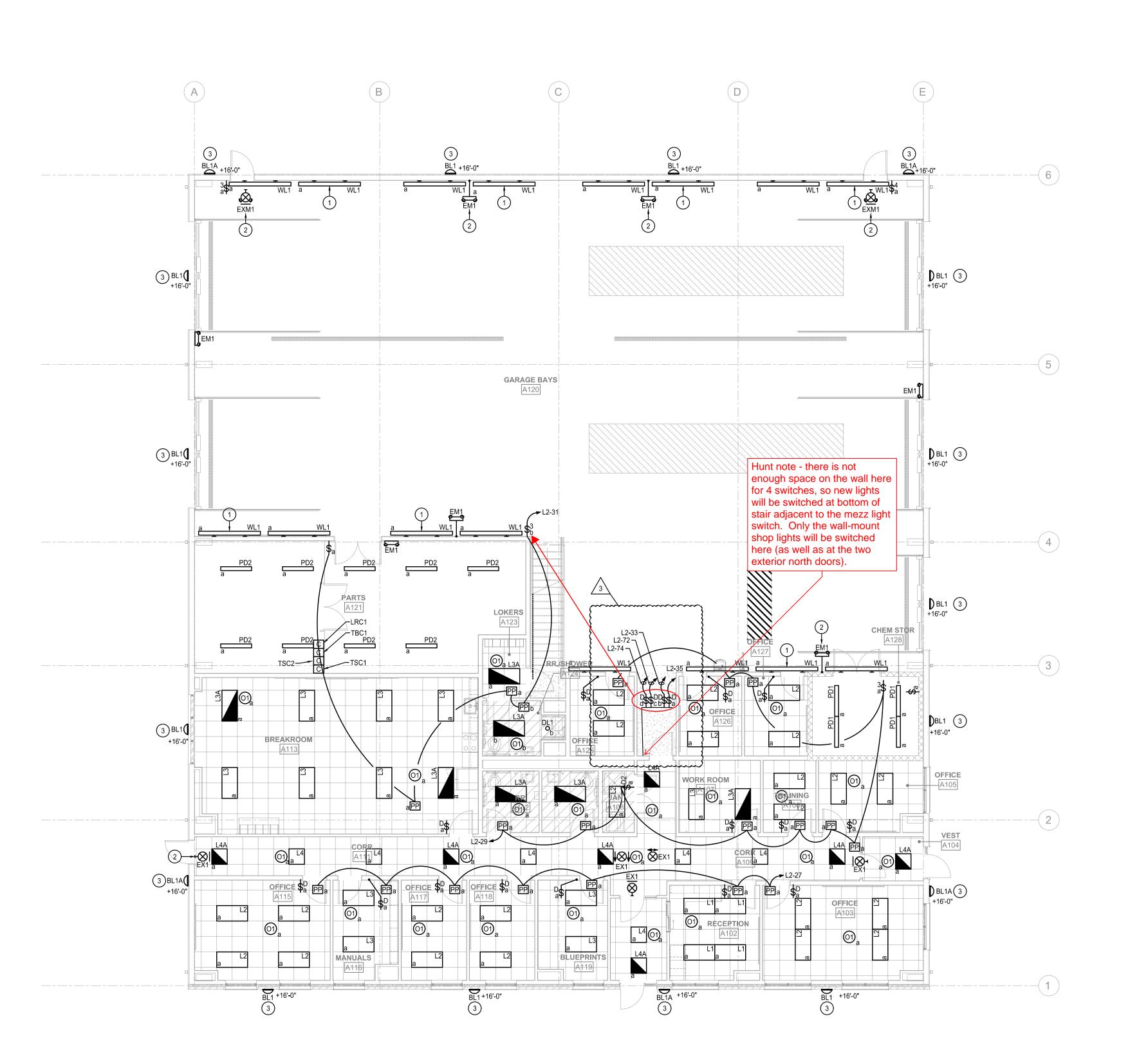

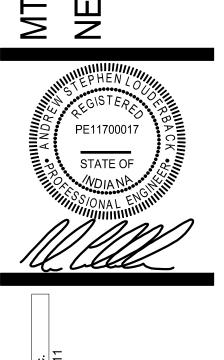

Ron has done a mock up and pictures are attached – We can physically squeeze the devices inside the box but it leaves almost no room for wire management/hardware (meaning install is double sided tape that tends to fail after the first

hot/cold cycle) and as you can see for a couple of the pics, the lid is going to bend the jumper cable connection and eventually will be a cause for lost/interrupted signal or poor performance.

Our vendor has contacted the supplier and because we would be placing a replacement order with them, they lowered the cost on the new boxes (he did not say exact but it looks about like 10-15%). So we will have the cost of the new boxes, a credit back for the previously purchased boxes, a restock fee of 30% of original box cost (this is not very commoRn to see them allow a restock on stainless products) and you have to pay the freight back to them. The boxes are almost double the size of the original spec so I have added a little labor for the boxes as well as the little bit of additional strut and hardware it will take to mount them.

These boxes are 24" wide X 24" tall x 8" deep. This should give extra top/bottom room as well as depth needed to not bend or stress the cables & connections. I had excluded this from my ASI 8 pricing as I was unsure if this would be required.

Please let me know if you have any questions – if this is approved, I need to move pretty quickly as they went from about 20 in stock at time of ASI 8 pricing to now only 3 in stock and the balance of 3 are 5 weeks + freight.

Worth noting, I am planning to do all 6 boxes because they all have the issue of the jumper cable sticking up – the canopies take the extra device inside of them but gates would have the same issue you see in the picture where the cable extends beyond the frame of the box. Ron will be at the meeting tomorrow and we can run through this if you have any questions.
