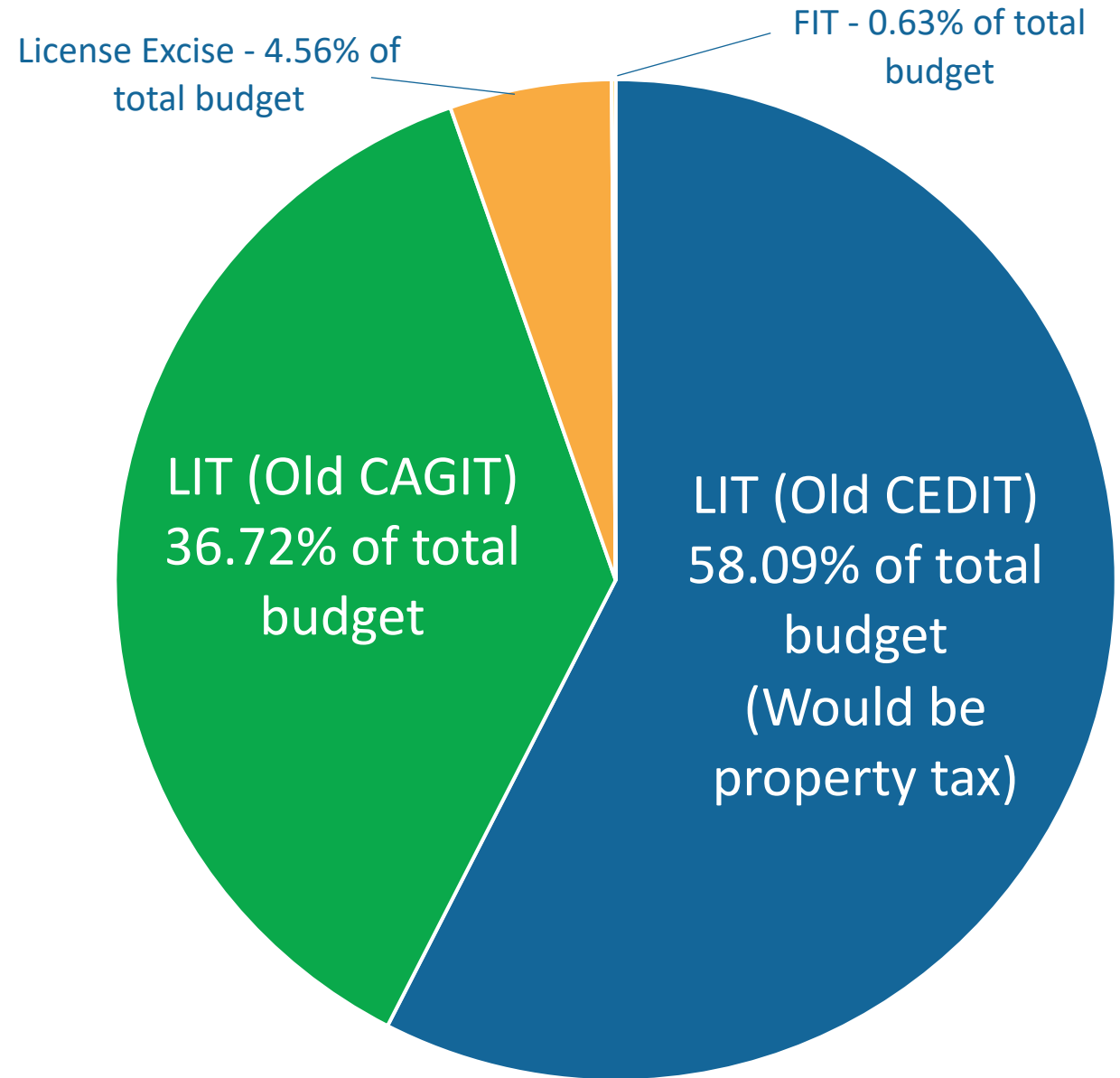

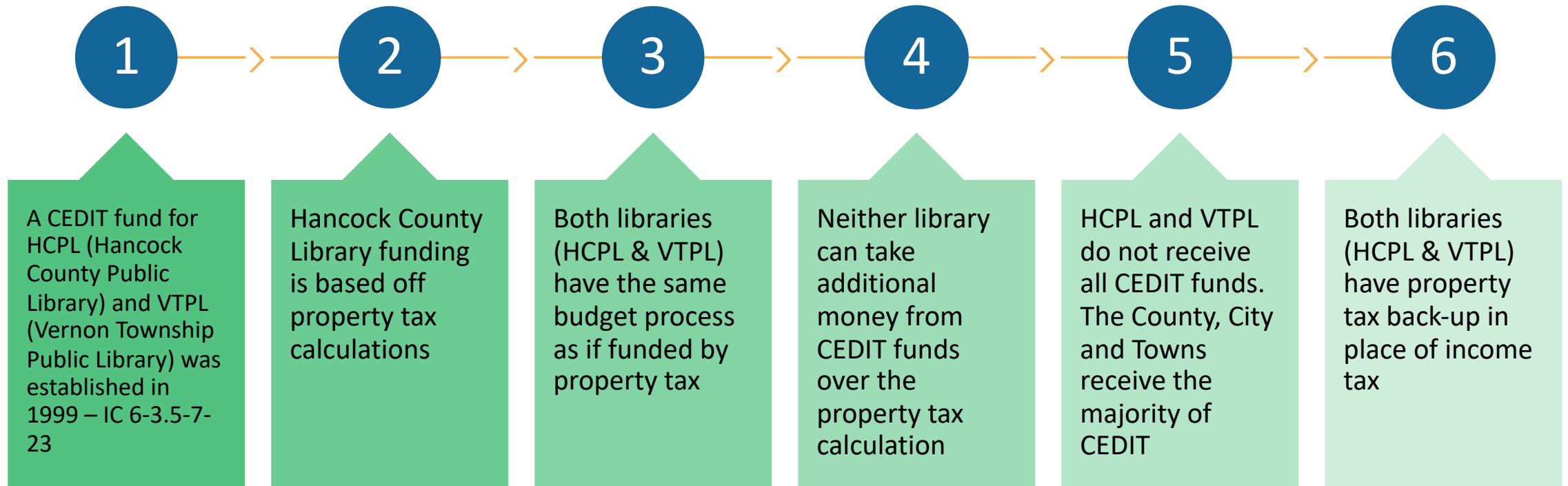
# HCPLibrary Funding

- CEDIT – County Economic Development Income Tax

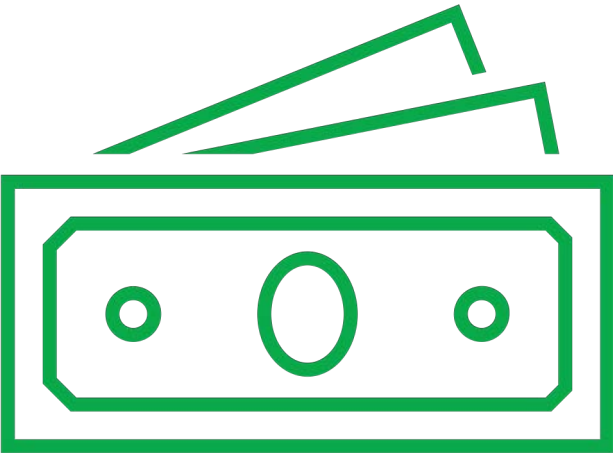


# HCPLibrary Funding is Unique

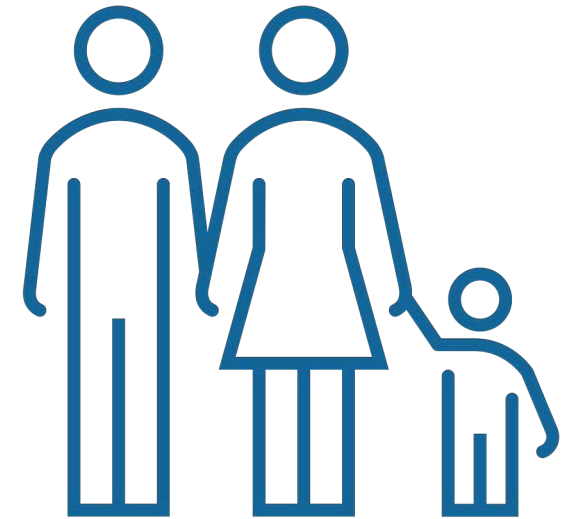

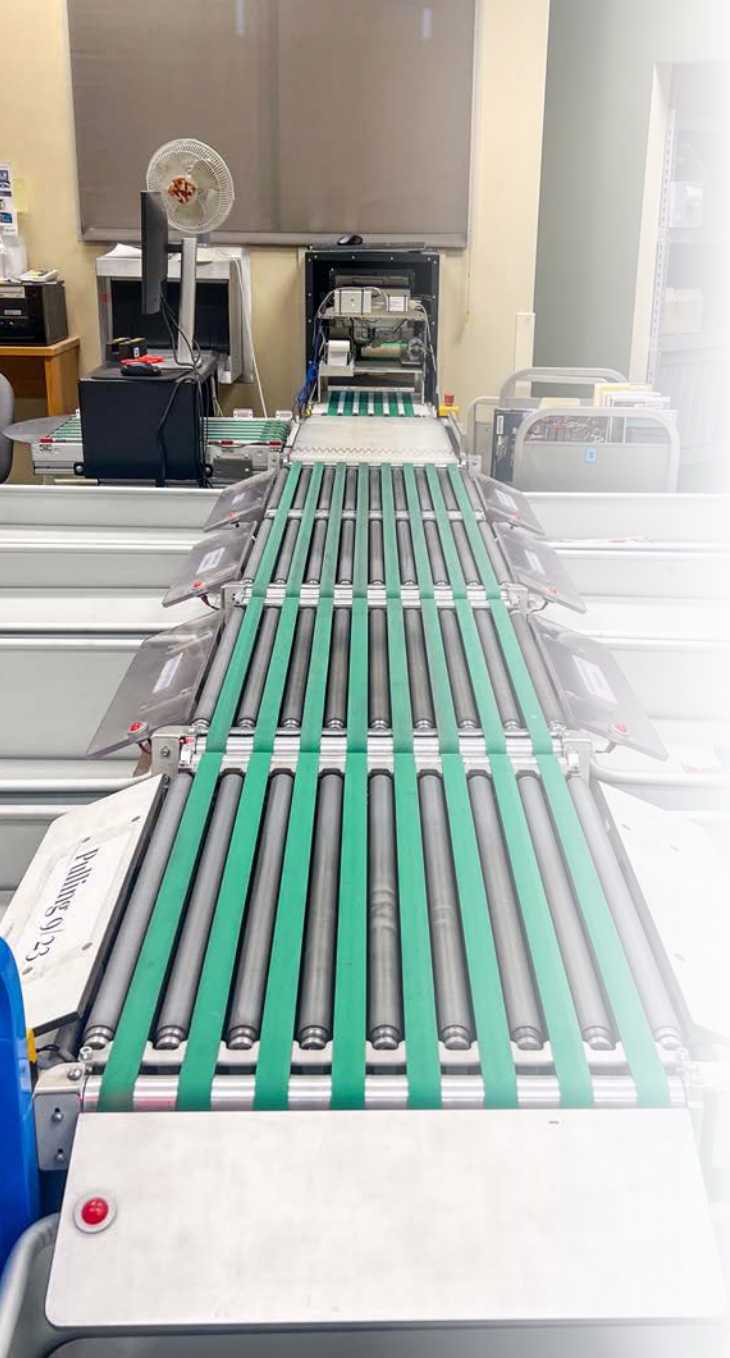
# Other 2023 Stats

- Replacement Boilers (Greenfield) – Summer

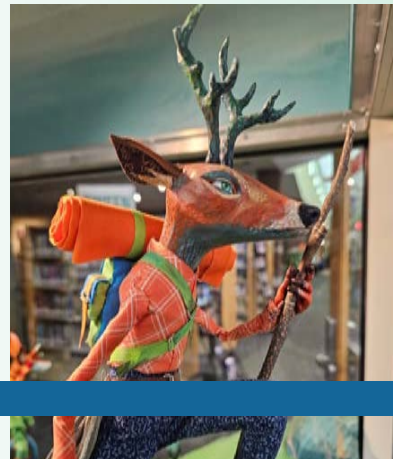
