# **Goal 1: Fostering a Sense of Belonging**

**Objective: Every student has at least one adult who connects with them on a regular basis.**

- **Clubs/Co-Curricular/Athletics**
  - Host Club Rush Week
  - 19 sports, co-curricular courses, and many clubs
  - 64% of all students are currently involved in a club, co-curricular activity, or sport
- **TBRI**
  - High school staff utilize TBRI strategies to connect with students.
  - Staff receive ongoing TBRI training.



# **Goal 1: Fostering a Sense of Belonging**

**Objective: Every student has at least one adult who connects with them on a regular basis.**

- **Targeted Support**

- Our MTSS committee meets regularly to support at-risk students.
- Our counselors and life coach meet with at-risk students.
- Developing the Marauder Mentor Match Program.



## **Goal 3: Elevate Student Learning & College/Career Planning**

**Objective: Increase/Excel Collegiate and trade certification opportunities**

- **Key Result: Increase the dual credit credentialed teachers by one each year.**
  - **2023-2024 - 15 teachers**
  - **2024-2025 - 16 teachers**
  - **2025-2026 - 17 teachers**
  - **We have five additional teachers interested in DCC and/or starting the process.**



# **Goal 3: Elevate Student Learning & College/Career Planning**

**Objective: Increase/Excel Collegiate and trade certification opportunities**

- **Key Result: Increase the dual credits earned by students by 5% annually.**
  - **2023-2024 - 815 credits**
  - **2024-2025 - 937 credits (Increase of 15%)**
  - **2025-2026 - TBD**



# **Goal 3: Elevate Student Learning & College/Career Planning**

**Objective: Increase/Excel Collegiate & trade certification opportunities**

- **Key Result: The graduating class of 2028 will have 40 or more students earning the Indiana College Core Certificate.**
  - 2024-2025 - 3 Students
  - 2025-2026 - TBD
  - We are adding dual credit courses strategically to make earning the ICC easier. Our EC program will help with this (class of 2030) because students will be cohorted in specific courses.



# **Goal 3: Elevate Student Learning & College/Career Planning**

## **Objective: Increase/Excel Collegiate & trade certification opportunities**

- Early College Program
  - Earned the Rural Early College Network Grant - \$120,000 over 5 years
  - Students in the 2030 cohort will be our first Early College cohort
  - Goals of the program
    - Provide additional supports to teachers and counselors
    - Increase dual credit course offerings, which also helps with the ICC
    - Earn an early college certification for Mt. Vernon High School
    - Provide additional support to students to
      - Increase students' college readiness and post-secondary acceptance
      - Improve attendance
      - Improve success in high school and college-level dual credit courses
      - Improve performance on college readiness exams
      - Provide an opportunity to earn an associates degree



# **Goal 3: Elevate Student Learning & College/Career Planning**

**Objective: Increase/Excel Collegiate & trade certification opportunities**

- **Key Result: Increase the number of students earning a trade certification by 5% annually, ensuring programs are aligned with student interests and career goals.**
  - 2023-2024 - 33 certifications
  - 2024-2025 - 61 certifications (85% increase)



# Goal 3: Elevate Student Learning and College/Career Planning

Objective: Increase Student Learning

- **Key Result: Increase the average SAT passing score to 1015 by July 2028**

# **Goal 3: Elevate Student Learning & College/Career Planning**

## **OBJECTIVE: DEVELOP COMPREHENSIVE LEARNING PLANS**

- **Key Result: Each student in grades 8-12 will have a personalized educational plan guiding them through graduation, involving regular updates and reviews.**
  - We are working with our leadership team to develop a student-tracking system that is not redundant and does not add more work for teachers.
  - Currently, in most classes, students can see their Essential Learning progress in Skyward through their assessment grades. Additionally, PSAT and SAT scores are also in Skyward.



# **Goal 3: Elevate Student Learning & College/Career Planning**

## **OBJECTIVE: DEVELOP COMPREHENSIVE LEARNING PLANS**

- **Key Result: Students in grades 3-12 will actively track their learning progress on Essential Learnings, NWEA, and standardized testing, with regular reviews and updates in Skyward.**
  - 9th-grade students recently completed their four-year plans after a presentation from counselors about graduation and course requirements.
  - We are currently reviewing different systems for completing the 4-year plan. Our goal is for systems to be effective and student/staff-friendly.
