

Virtual Program Handbook Changes 2026-2027

- **Registration (page 1)**

- Clarified that a meeting must be held in order to be virtual
 - Students who want to be considered must meet with their parent(s) and counselor
- Updated attendance expectations
 - attendance expectations of no more than 10 unexcused absences in previous semester
- Added being on track to graduate to participate in the program
 - Being on track to graduate prior to participation in the Virtual Program
- Updated registration completed prior to or within the first ten days of the start of the semester
 - Registration completed before or within the first ten days of the semester starting;

- **Enrollment & Eligibility (page 1-2)**

- Updated attendance expectations
 - Maintain good attendance (fewer than ten unexcused absences per semester)
- Added required in-person attendance for state-mandated testing
 - Come in person for state-mandated testing (when applicable)

- **Grades (page 3)**

- Updated how grades are reflected on transcripts
 - will be added to transcripts based on the MVHS grading scale

- **State Testing (page 3)**

- Added requirements for state-mandated testing
 - Failure to do so will result in removal from the virtual program.

- **Graduation Requirements & Diploma (page 3)**

- Removed cohort specific designations (rankings and Latin Honors)
 - ~~Beginning with the 2029 cohort, virtual students will not be included in Latin Honors, and the cohorts 2027 and 2028 will not be included in Class Rankings.~~

- **Extracurricular Participation (page 3)**
 - Updated wording to specify what virtual students can/cannot participate in
 - Virtual students can attend MV events, such as performances, dances, and sporting events, but they cannot participate in extracurricular and cocurricular activities, such as clubs and sports. Virtual students who are under a Form 16 may not attend school events or participate in extracurricular activities.
